

How to apply

Step 1 - TERM 1

All specialist programs have an application process that begins with an application form. These forms will be given to students through our feeder primary schools by the end of Term 1 or emailed on request.

Step 2 - TERM 2

Students who submit an application form by the due date will be invited to participate in a selection process. The process differs depending on the specialist program that is being applied for. For example, Adventure Recreation applicants are often invited to a practical interview while CASP applicants may require a portfolio.

Step 3 - TERM 3

Successful applicants are notified and requested to confirm their acceptance. This usually occurs by the end of Term 3.

N.B. enrolment paperwork must be completed to secure a place.

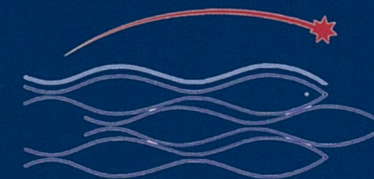

Adventure Recreation Program (Ad Rec)

CHALLENGE, EXPERIENCE, GROW, LEAD

The Adventure Recreation program takes advantage of the unique environments that surround Warnbro Community High School such as the Shoalwater Marine Park and the Darling Range. Students participate in activities such as abseiling, snorkelling, rock climbing, sailing, fishing, surfing and mountain biking.

Students in the Adventure Recreation program are taught environmental principals such as 'leave no trace ethics', risk management and ecological sustainability. The program aims to enhance the personal development, leadership and self-esteem of our students, whilst fostering environmental awareness.

The Adventure Recreation program at WCHS is one of only two such programs offered in the state. It caters for students with interests in all aspects of 'the outdoors'.
